We learn about camouflage techniques, how a baby acquires language, how to read a WPA-era post office mural, and why Martone sold his stock in the *New Yorker* and reinvested his money in the company that makes *Etch A Sketch*. *Unconventions* then is Martone's Frankensteinian monster, a kind of unruly hybrid spawn of the mainstream writing enterprise. Writing seems to me an intrinsic pleasure, an end in itself, first says Martone.
