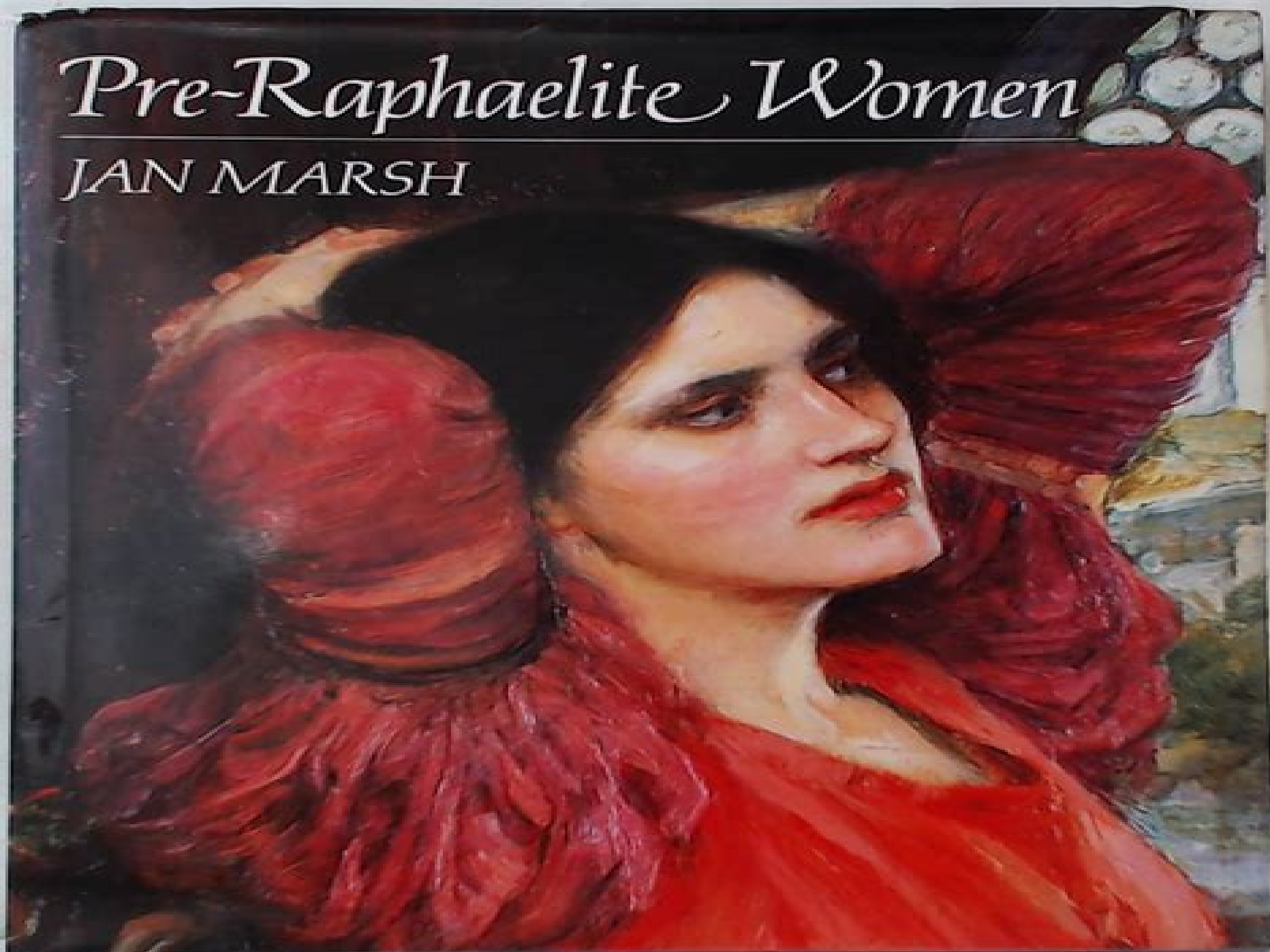

men but pale faced young women with lustrous tumbling locks that spring to mind gazing soulfully from the picture frame or in dramatic scenes painted in glowing colours Who were these women What is known of their lives and their roles in a movement that in successive phases spanned over half a century Some were models plucked from obscurity to pose for figures in Pre Raphaelite paintings while others were sisters wives daughters and friends of the artists Several were artists themselves with aspirations to match those of the men sharing the same artistic and social networks yet condemned by their gender to occupy a separate sphere Others inhabited and sustained a male dominated art world as partners in production maintaining households and studios and socialising with patrons Some were skilled in the arts of interior decoration dressmaking embroidery jewellery making the fine crafts that formed a supportive tier for the higher arts of painting and sculpture And although their backgrounds and life experiences certainly varied widely all were engaged in creating Pre Raphaelite art
