First and Second Introductions to the Doctrine of Science Johann Fichte, Fichte's First Introduction to the Doctrine of Science 1797 is both a programmatic self positioning and a polemical clarification of post Kantian transcendental philosophy written at Jena at the height of his early career it claims fidelity to Kant's critical revolution while rejecting both dogmatism Spinozistic or materialist appeals to a Ding an sich and half measures among Kant's epigones and it advances a rigorously genetic method that derives the entire structure of experience from the self positing activity of the I Ich conceived as pure doing rather than as a substance The text's biographical voice addressing students defending the project against mockery and promising a sustained exposition prefigures the controversies that soon engulfed him and underlines his conviction that philosophy is an ethical task of intellectual self assertion Philosophically it radicalizes Kant by internalizing necessity into the lawful action of intelligence turning the thing in itself into a mere heuristic fiction and grounding objectivity in the lawful productivity of consciousness at the same time it foreshadows and challenges Hegel whose later absolute idealism will universalize and de subjectivize this productivity into the self unfolding of Geist criticizing Fichte s primacy of the finite I as still subjective Thus the Introduction occupies a pivotal moment it is the decisive bridge from Kant s critique to the grand systematic ambitions that Hegel will consummate even as it insists against both on the primacy of practical freedom as philosophy's first fact Fichte's Second Introduction to the Science of Knowledge penned in 1797 amid his tenure at the University of Jena and shortly before the Atheism Controversy that would lead to his dismissal represents a pivotal moment in his philosophical evolution serving as a clarion call to those entrenched in existing systems to reconsider the foundations of knowledge through the lens of transcendental idealism Biographically this work emerges from Fichte's fervent engagement with Kant's critical philosophy which he encountered as a struggling tutor and which propelled him to fame via his 1792 Attempt at a Critique of All Revelation initially mistaken for Kant's own yet Fichte radicalizes Kant's Copernican turn by positing the self active I Ich as the absolute starting point where consciousness arises not from passive intuition but from the dynamic Tathandlung a fact act of self positing that generates both self and world thereby addressing what Fichte saw as Kant's residual dogmatism in assuming a thing in itself beyond the subject's reach This delineates a methodological shift from analytic reasoning on dead concepts to experimental observation of the living mind emphasizing intellectual intuition as the unifying bridge between sensible and intelligible realms with human finitude necessitating
