Canada is often called a pluralist state but few commentators view Aboriginal self government from the perspective of political pluralism Instead Aboriginal identity is framed in terms of cultural and national traits while self government is taken to represent an Aboriginal desire to protect those traits *Shifting Boundaries* challenges this view arguing that it fosters a woefully incomplete understanding of the politics of self government Taking the position that a relational theory of pluralism offers a more accurate interpretation Tim Schouls contends that self government is better understood when an identification perspective on Aboriginal identity is adopted instead of a cultural or national one
