The advent of non-invasive functional brain imaging has clarified which regions of the brain are recruited during sexual arousal. Injuries to those regions, and to the spinal cord and peripheral nerves that link genitalia to limbic and cognitive centres, can profoundly influence sexual wellbeing. In epilepsy, expressions of hypersexuality and hyposexuality interact with the location of epileptogenic foci in the temporolimbic circuitry, and are tempered by the sexual effects of drug treatments. We outline the sexual consequences of epilepsy, stroke, multiple sclerosis, Parkinson's disease, and other common neurological disorders. Management of sexual dysfunction from both disease and treatment is discussed. Nerve-sparing techniques could mitigate the substantial sexual dysfunction in both men and women through surgical disruption of the autonomic nerves during radical pelvic surgery.

Introduction

Neurological disease frequently alters sexual response, and patients might regard their sexual loss to be its most devastating aspect.¹ We seek to explore the sexual consequences of demyelinating disorders, traumatic and vascular injuries to the brain, and the special relation between sexual function and treatments given to alleviate epilepsy and Parkinson's disease. We also explore the profound effects that might arise as a result of accidental trauma to the spinal cord or of surgical trauma to the peripheral nerves as a result of treatment for pelvic malignancies.

Neurological disorder can change the processing of sexual stimuli to preclude arousal, to decrease or increase desire, or to curtail genital engorgement.

Alternatively, engorgement and spontaneous orgasms can constitute epileptic phenomena. Interruption of the long spinal tracts between cortex and sacral cord or the pelvic autonomic nerves interferes with genital engorgement, erections, ejaculation, and climax. Neurological disease can also challenge the physical ability to embrace, stimulate, engage in intercourse, and maintain urinary and bowel continence during sexual activity.

Limitations of existing data on the incidence and nature of sexual dysfunction are outlined in the accompanying manuscript on sexual sequelae of general medical disorders.² We cite controlled prevalence studies and randomised placebo-controlled treatment trials, unless they are unavailable, in which case we refer to treatments based on open label studies or clinical experience and note the low level of evidence.

The neurophysiology and neuroanatomy of sexuality

Sex begins in the brain: a series of human experiments in the early 1960s measured intensely pleasurable sexual feelings in association with deep brain stimulation of so-called reward sites, such as the amygdala,

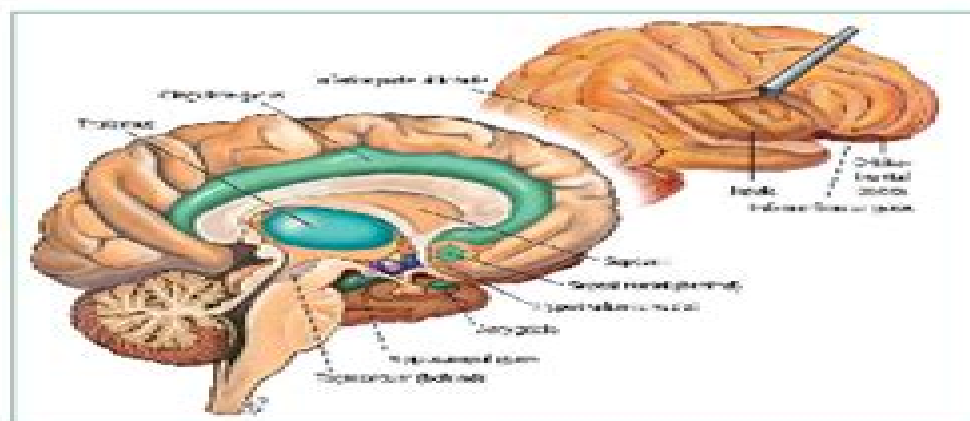


Figure 1: Regions of sexual function in the brain. The limbic system is shown in green. The limbic system includes the posterior cingulate cortex and much of the insula.

Search strategy

We searched the Cochrane Library, EMBASE, and MEDLINE through OVID and PubMed. We used the key words "sexual dysfunction", "erectile dysfunction", and "sexual disorders" in combination with "stroke", "head injury", "epilepsy", "Parkinson's disease", "spinal cord injury", "multiple sclerosis", and "peripheral neuropathies". We also searched for "autonomic nervous system" in combination with "rectal cancer", "cervical cancer", "bladder cancer", and "prostate cancer". We mainly selected publications in the past 5 years, but did not exclude commonly referenced and highly regarded older publications. We also searched the reference list of articles identified by this search strategy.
