

Elizabeth, was thus circulated in manuscript form for the benefit of informed and sympathetic readers. Debra Rienstra and Noel Kinnamon claim that scribal publication was best suited to the controversial claims the Psalms implicitly made about religion and literature. Michael Brennan studies the poetic relationship between Ben Jonson and Lady Mary Wroth and traces Jonson's role in Wroth's transition from a private to a public figure in the second decade of the seventeenth century. He shows how a small coterie was instrumental in helping Wroth to enter the sphere of print. In her essay, Victoria Burke examines the history and significance of Anne, Lady Southwell's poetic oeuvre in manuscript. Through a study of the manuscripts, she is able to show that in spite of her claim to modesty, Lady Southwell intended her poetry to be read. In the following essay, Margaret Ezell discusses the reasons why women's manuscripts were published posthumously. Leigh Eicke studies how Jane Barker uses scribal conventions tactically in her (Jacobite) printed texts for political as well as literary purposes, and she thus unearths the interactions that exist between manuscript exchanges and published works. Kathryn King looks at Elizabeth Singer Rowe's move from manuscript to print and back to manuscript: her fascinating essay shows how Rowe, known as the "Pindaric Lady," uses both modes of publication to her own benefit, printing her religious works, but asserting her new social status by circulating works in manuscript among a coterie of elegant readers. Isobel Grundy contrasts the early manuscript writings of Lady Mary Wortley Montagu with those of her daughter and niece to show the emergence, through manuscript, of a nonliterary "teenage" counterculture in the course of the eighteenth century. In the final essay, George Justice looks at Fanny Burney's manuscript play, *The Warnings*, which her father paradoxically dissuaded her from publishing. In this play, Burney denounced scribal publication as a relic of an oppressive aristocratic culture to be rejected and satirized the coterie of bluestockings around Elizabeth Montagu. Burney's literary ambitions demanded that she rejected the still powerful mode of scribal publication in favor of print and performance for the "public" she claimed she was writing for. The narrative underlying the book ends with the "ambiguous triumph of print" (Love's phrase), but *Women's Writing and the Circulation of Ideas* forces us to revise our notion of the significance of scribal publication for women.
