

would indicate. However, acetophenetidin (Phenacetin) is only mentioned as the metabolic precursor of acetaminophen; the fact that this drug is still incorporated into many combination analgesics, such as Darvon Compound-65 and others, is ignored. Furthermore, the clear risk associated with the continued and prolonged use of phenacetin at even modest levels are not mentioned in the text. Its effect on the renal tubules and potential carcinogenesis should not be ignored. It is true there are scattered references to phenacetin elsewhere in the text, but its notable absence from chapter 41 could be misleading to the student.

The index of the book seems to be satisfactory since cross-references appear. This is an important aspect for the student who is not yet familiar with the generic-versus-trade-name problem that confronts us all daily.

Overall, the book is useful for the beginning student who has his or her first exposure to pharmacology, since it is not overwhelming and is easy to read. It cannot be recommended as a basic reference work, for which it is not intended. Finally, the publisher is to be commended for producing a hardback book with technical content at a reasonable cost in these days of sky-high book prices.

Ambulatory care: For the house officer

Edited by Norman Diamond, et al. Pp. 258. Williams & Wilkins Co., 428 E. Preston St., Baltimore 21202, 1982. \$9.95 (paper).

This pocket-sized manual covers twenty-four medical situations that are commonly seen on an ambulatory basis, as the title indicates. The authors first conceived this volume in 1973. It apparently received such a good response that they wrote this 1982 version.

The editors all discuss their varied topics somewhat in the manner of a physical diagnosis book, that is, signs and symptoms first, and then disease syndromes along with management guidelines. The text is well outlined and augmented with charts, highlights, and schemata.

In conclusion, this is a small and fine volume covering succinctly a number of medical topics common in ambulatory care. A possible shortcoming is that it may be too restrictive in topics and material.

Peptic ulcer

By D.W. Piper. Pp. 94, with illus. ADIS Health Science Press, John Wright-PSG Inc, U.S. distributor, 545 Great Rd., Littleton, Mass. 01460, 1982. \$12.50 (paperbound).

Almost 20 percent of persons will suffer from peptic ulcers during their lifetime. The mortality of peptic ulcer disease meets or exceeds the number of deaths from motor vehicle accidents. The ability to diagnose and treat peptic ulcer disease has been made much easier by the use of double-contrast radiography, endoscopy, and cimetidine therapy. *Peptic ulcer* is not directed at the gastroenterologist, but at that large number of physicians who first provide care for the patients suffering with peptic ulcer.

Peptic ulcer is an easy-to-read book that is essentially a monograph. It is divided into ten chapters covering peptic ulceration, chronic peptic ulceration, special ulcer-related problems, diagnoses, the role of analgesic and anti-inflammatory drugs, the differential diagnosis of ulcer-like syndromes, complications of peptic ulcer, drug and non-drug treatment of ulcers, management of chronic peptic ulcer and its complications, and surgery for peptic ulcerations. Graphs, tables, photographs, and columns of data abound. The liberal use of highlights emphasizes the important points.

The treatment of peptic ulcer dis-

ease varies in different parts of the world. This author is from Sidney, Australia, and his use of drugs is somewhat different from that which we are currently using here in the United States. The reader's perspectives are broadened by obtaining new information in the treatment of peptic ulcer disease. Most of the drugs that we consider new have been used in other parts of the world for several years prior to their introduction in the United States. Dr. Piper also does an exemplary job of dispelling several myths about the treatment of peptic ulcer.

This short book provides a good overview to a problem that primary-care physicians see on a daily basis. *Peptic ulcer* is an economical addition to the library of the general internist or family physician. It is very easy to read and is useful as a reference.

"Sexual therapy and sexual counseling," the fourth chapter, contains "the meat" of the book. Here, Dr. Croft discusses the treatment of impotence, premature ejaculation, retarded ejaculation, orgasmic dysfunction, vaginismus, and sexual therapy with the physician as a counselor. This section also includes a table that provides an evaluation of the sexual problems of the elderly. Particular attention is paid to drug history; the drugs which are commonly thought to interfere with sexuality are explored. A communication skill chart illustrates questions
