the medieval chronicler Adam of Bremen (c. 1040–c. 1081) wrote about the worship of a curious idol that would bestow pleasure on humans. This idol was said to be located at Uppsala, in what is now Sweden, in the eleventh century. The pursuit of pleasure is a ubiquitous feature of human societies, pre-literary and heroic, ancient, medieval, or modern. It is therefore no surprise that Adam of Bremen found evidence for the worship of a pleasure-giving idol in the Nordic region during the late Viking Age.

Within his history of the archdiocese of Hamburg-Bremen, in the fourth book, where he writes about the lands to the north, Adam of Bremen describes three statues said to be at Uppsala. The first is of Thor (Porr), who is said to be connected with the elements and agriculture; the second of Wodan (Odinn), who is said to be connected with war; and "Tercius est Fricco, pacem voluptatemque largiens mortalibus. Cuius etiam simulacrum fingunt cum ingenti priapo" (Adam von Bremen 1917, 258) ["The third is Frikko, who bestows peace and pleasure on mortals. His likeness, too, they fashion with an immense phallus" (Adam of Bremen 1959, 207)]. Adam follows the descriptions of these idols with information about the priests who offer the statues sacrifices on behalf of humans, indicating specifically that when marriages are celebrated, a sacrifice is made to Frikko (Freyr). The source for Adam's knowledge of these pagan sacrifices at Uppsala was an unnamed Christian (Tschan 1959, xx). What is most significant here is that Adam of Bremen's text indicates there were people in Uppsala
