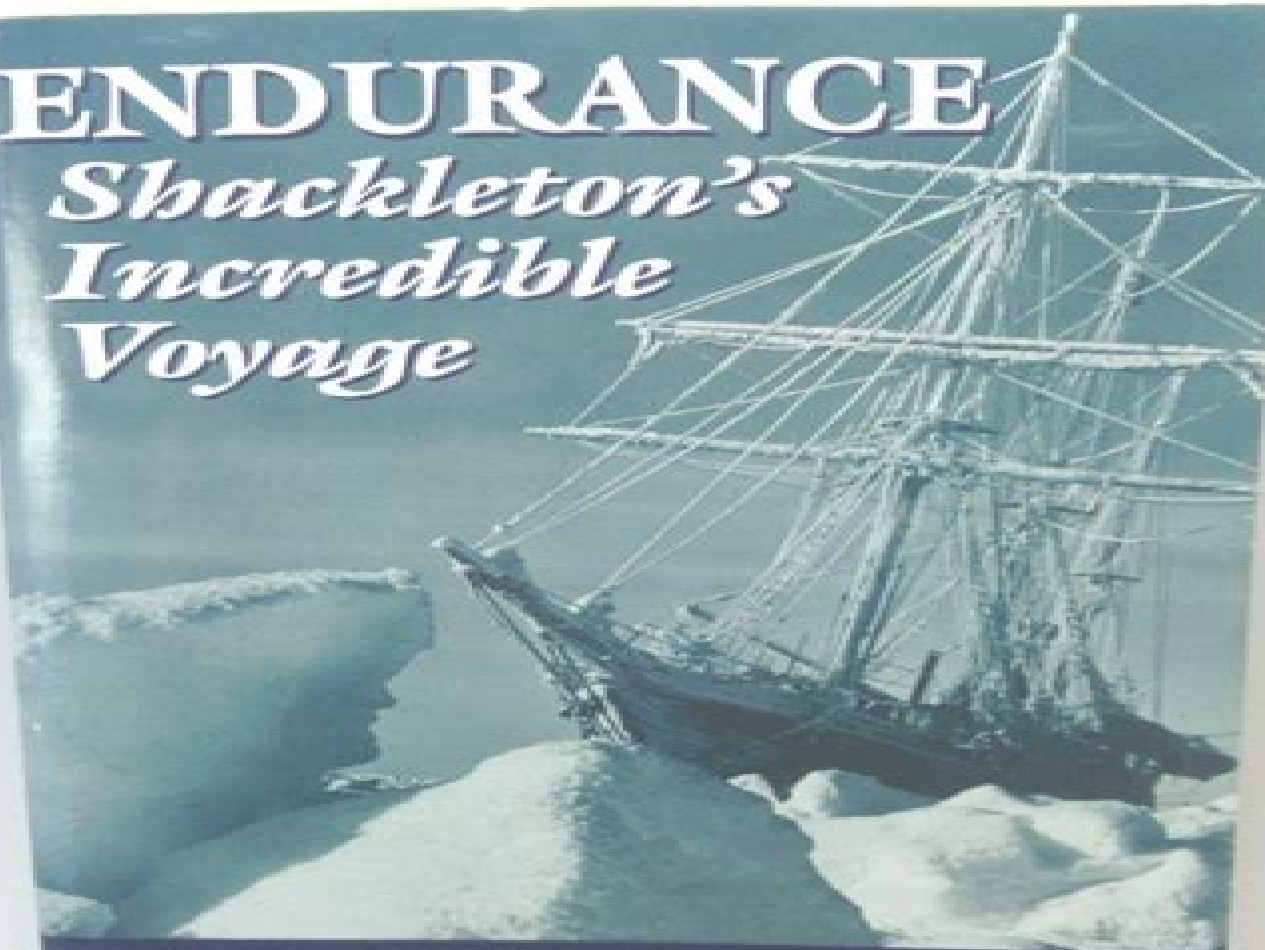

South Ernest Shackleton, Sir Ernest Henry Shackleton, 1999 In 1911 Roald Amundsen beat Robert Falcon Scott to the South Pole and Scott and his colleagues all died on the return journey Ernest Shackleton who had served with Scott on a previous expedition decided that crossing Antarctica from sea to sea was the last great unattempted journey on the continent His Imperial Trans Antarctic Expedition of 1914-17 was a failure But perhaps because it failed with Shackleton not only surviving but bringing his crew back alive the expedition became more famous than many of those adventurous voyages that succeeded After reaching the Weddell Sea off the coast of the Antarctic Peninsula Shackleton's ship the Endurance became trapped in pack ice and spent 1915 drifting northwards The Endurance was eventually crushed by the ice and sank leaving 28 men stranded on the ice They spent months sheltering from the subzero temperatures as the pack ice continued to drift Eventually Shackleton accepted they could not rely on rescue and had to help themselves so he led five men on an 800 mile voyage in an

open boat to reach South Georgia from where he was able to mount a rescue of all of the men he had left behind on the ice. but there are few stories as compelling as his The Antarctic is a harsh place of bitter cold and darkness where only the strong and resourceful can hope to survive Crean was such a man Had he weakened and failed somewhere along the way of his adventurous life the lives of all might well have been lost and their stories remained untold He left no diary or book his few letters speak modestly of his exploits if at all Hold Fast tells the story of a common man in uncommon circumstances who met every challenge as it came with steadfast purpose If he knew fear he never showed it He left England with Shackleton s Endurance expedition in August 1914 expecting to be the first to cross the Antarctic continent and come home to lasting fame Things didn t work out according to plan From the moment his ship Endurance was caught in the ice and crushed throughout the long sojourn of the shipwrecked sailors on the floating ice floe he took every setback with casual aplomb as though he did this sort of thing every day When twenty eight men were forced to take to sea in three small boats he took the helm of one of them To save those men Crean was one of six who crossed the stormy southern ocean in an open boat to land on an inhospitable shore The journey was not over yet Three men must cross the glaciers guarding the forbidding interior of South Georgia to get help Tom Crean was one of them We share his trials as they happen the thrill of discovery the danger of the sea ice the terror of extreme isolation Tom Crean was not most renowned of the explorers during those early years of Antarctic discovery For that the palms go to Shackleton Amundsen and Scott with the names of other leaders not far behind Other men better educated and connected would publish the stories of hardship and adventure that astonished the world Crean s name is occasionally mentioned in these works as it should be his was a distinguished career of service not as a leader but as a seaman His story is not one of trial and privation leading to a tragic end because without one man s endurance and unflinching resolve in the face of hopeless adversity there would be no survivors The familiar names belong to those who claimed to lead but those who lead are nothing without those who come a few steps behind hauling the gear pitching the camp walking the long walk steadfast enduring Without them there would be no leaders There would be no survivors and no story to be told

The Story of Shackleton's Last Expedition, 1914-1917** Sir Ernest Henry Shackleton, 2020-09-28 I decided to leave South Georgia about December 5 and in the intervals of final preparation scanned again the plans for the voyage to winter quarters What welcome was the Weddell Sea preparing for us The whaling captains at South Georgia were generously ready to share with me their knowledge of the waters in which they pursued their trade and while confirming earlier information as to the extreme severity of the ice conditions in this sector of the Antarctic they were able to give advice that was worth attention It will be convenient to state here briefly some of the considerations that weighed with me at that time and in the weeks that followed I knew that the ice had come far north that season and after listening to the suggestions of the whaling captains had decided to steer to the South Sandwich Group round Ultima Thule and work as far to the eastward as the fifteenth meridian west longitude before pushing south The whalers emphasized the difficulty of getting through the ice in the neighbourhood of the South Sandwich Group They told me they had often seen the floes come right up to the group in the summer time and they thought the Expedition would have to push through heavy pack in order to reach the Weddell Sea Probably the best time to get into the Weddell Sea would be the end of February or the beginning of March The whalers had gone right round the South Sandwich Group and they were familiar with the conditions The predictions they made induced me to take the deck load of coal for if we had to fight our way through to Coats Land we would need every ton of fuel the ship could carry I hoped that by first moving to the east as far as the fifteenth meridian west we would be able to go south through looser ice pick up Coats Land and finally reach Vahsel Bay where Filchner made his attempt at landing in 1912 Two considerations were occupying my mind at this juncture I was anxious for certain reasons to winter the Endurance in the Weddell Sea but the difficulty of finding a safe harbour might be very great If no safe harbour could be found the ship must winter at South Georgia It seemed to me hopeless now to think of making the journey across the continent in the first summer as the season was far advanced and the ice conditions were likely to prove unfavourable In view of the possibility of wintering the ship in the ice we took extra clothing from the stores at the various stations in South Georgia **Shackleton's Heroes** Wilson McOrist, 2016-11-15 The Unbelievable Story of Six Men Who Trekged Across the Great Ice Barrier in Support of Ernest Shackleton's Antarctic Expedition One hundred years ago Sir Ernest Shackleton embarked on the legendary 1914-1917 Imperial Trans Antarctic Expedition defying the odds and accomplishing one of history's most remarkable feats of endurance while narrowly escaping death even though his crew failed in their mission to cross Antarctica His story inflated by time and celebrity has come to personify the Heroic Age of Antarctic Exploration Less well known however is the incredible but often forgotten tale of the Mount Hope Party also known as the Ross Sea party six men who worked in the shadow of Shackleton's greater cause Sent to the opposite side of the Polar
