Shafer, 2003 Where did the Era of Divided Government come from What sustains split partisan control of the institutions of American national government year after year Why can it shift so easily from Democratic or Republican presidencies coupled with Republican or Democratic Congresses How can the vast array of issues and personalities that have surfaced in American politics over the last forty years fit so neatly within indeed reinforce the sustaining political pattern of our time These big questions constitute the puzzle of modern American politics The old answer a majority and a minority party plus dominant and recessive public issues will not work in the Era of Divided Government Byron Shafer a political scientist who is regarded as one of the most comprehensive and original thinkers on American politics provides a convincing new answer that has three major elements These elements in combination not divided government as a catch phrase are the real story of politics in our time The first element is comprised of two great sets of public preferences that manifest themselves at the ballot box as two majorities The old cluster of economic and welfare issues has not so much been displaced as simply joined by a second cluster of cultural and national concerns The second element can be seen in the behavior of political parties and party activists whose own preferences don't match those of the general public That public remains reliably left of the active Republican Party on economic and welfare issues and reliably right of the active Democratic Party on cultural and national concerns The third crucial element is found in an institutional arrangement the distinctively American matrix of governmental institutions which converts those first two elements into a framework for policymaking year in and year out In the first half of the book Shafer

examines how dominant features of the Reagan first Bush Clinton and second Bush administrations reflect the interplay of these three elements Recent policy conflicts and institutional combatants in Shafer's analysis illuminate this new pattern of American politics In the second half he ranges across time and nations to put these modern elements and their composite pattern into a much larger historical and institutional framework In this light modern American politics appears not so much as new and different but as a distinctive recombination of familiar elements of a political style a political process and a political conflict that has been running for a much much longer time The Presidencies of Grover Cleveland Richard E. Welch, 1988 Grover Cleveland who served as both the twenty second and the twenty fourth president of the United States dominated the American political scene from 1884 to 1896 Viewed at one time as a monument of presidential courage Cleveland has over the past generation been dismissed by historians as a Bourbon Democrat the symbol of that wing of the Democratic party devoted to preserving the status quo and protecting the interests of the propertied In this revisionist study Richard Welch takes a fresh look at the Cleveland administrations and discovers a man whose assertive temperament was frequently at odds with his inherited political faith Although pledging public allegiance to a Whiggish version of the presidency Cleveland's aggressive insistence on presidential independence led him to exercise increasing control of the executive branch and then to seek influence over Congress and national legislation Ouick to denounce governmental paternalism and the centralization of political power Cleveland nevertheless expanded the authority of the national government as he revised federal land and Indian policies in the West and ordered the army to Chicago during the 1894 Pullman strike For all his fears of constitutional innovation he was neither a champion of big business nor unaware of the problems posed by the post Civil War economic revolution He signed the Interstate commerce Act warned against the growing power of industrial combination advocated voluntary federal arbitration of labor management disputes and fought the monopolization of western lands by railroad an timber corporations Welch places Cleveland s battles on behalf of tariff revision civil service reform and the gold standard within the context of the conundrum of a strong president who usually failed to gain the cooperation of Congress or the Democratic party Cleveland reinvigorated the American presidency and reestablished an equilibrium between the executive and legislative branches of the federal government but by his obdurate enmity to the silverites and the agrarian radicals he helped assure the division and defeat of his party in the election of 1896 Welch demonstrates that Cleveland's achievements and failures as a political leader were attributable to an authoritarian temperament that saw compromise as surrender Two chapters of the book are devoted to Cleveland's diplomacy focusing especially on his response to Hawaiian and Cuban revolutions and the boundary dispute between Venezuela and Great Britain Welch takes issue with the currently popular thesis that U S diplomacy in the last decade of the nineteenth century displayed a concerted governmental effort to solve domestic economic problems by expanding foreign markets in East Asia and Latin America In addition to providing insights into the character of one of our more interesting presidents this

reassessment of Grover Cleveland's historical legacy shows clearly that the Cleveland years served as the essential preface to Handbook of Politics Kevin T. the development of a modern presidency and to the identification for executive power Leicht, J.
