



Evaluation of pesticides residues in Greek peaches during 2002–2007 after the implementation of integrated crop management

ABSTRACT

The incidence and levels of pesticide residues in peaches grown using Integrated Crop Management (ICM) methods in Pella and Imathia, districts of Macedonia, Northern Greece, are hereby presented. A total of 1150 peach samples were collected pre-harvest (June–September) and were analysed during the period of 2002–2007. Residual levels of selected insecticides, fungicides and acaricides were determined by Gas Chromatography–Mass Spectrometry following solid phase extraction. The monitoring program is extended up to 21 pesticides. Twenty-two of them were measured above detection limit, and 8 of them were found present every year. Insecticides represent the highest incidence amongst pesticide categories (654 positive samples, 56.50%) while chlorpyrifos is the most frequent within the category (491 positive samples). The incidence of pyrethrins was the highest in 2007 (26.8%) while bifenox was detected most frequently within this category (67 positive samples in 2007). Traceable levels of pesticides were lower than the Maximum Residue Limits (MRLs) in all peach samples. Variations in incidence and levels of pesticides are attributed to some extent to the weather conditions as well as due to abundance by the guidelines of agronomists during blowing and harvest period. Monitoring in agricultural products could be employed as the first step in a chain of biomonitoring studies in humans, and may also be proven to be a good and ample indicator of exposure.

1. Introduction

Integrated crop management (ICM) cultivation includes guidelines which farmer unions use to enforce actions for the production of safe agricultural products, with simultaneous respect to the environment (Greek Ministry of Agriculture & Supervision of Agricultural Products, 1999a). ICM is a system that includes measures for good agricultural practice, for safety and hygiene of workers, for safety of products, for full traceability of measurements and for preservation of the environment. For instance, ICM allows all pesticides registered in conventional cultivations, while stipulating specific instructions for the application on crops (Greek Ministry of Agriculture & Supervision of Agricultural Products, 1999b).

Based on FAO statistics, Greece is the fifth largest world producer of peaches (<http://www.fao.org/stat/fao.org/site/339/default.asp>). Macedonia (prefectures of Imathia and Pella) being the

main area of cultivation. Since 1998, application of ICM is strongly enforced.

The Greek national authority for the application of ICM, AGRO-GEIT, has published two models 'AGRO 2.1 Specifications' and 'AGRO 2.2 Requirements'. The first includes general requirements in agricultural practice that can be inspected objectively. It constitutes the initial concepts for the certification of the ICM system that is applicable in every agricultural practice regardless of the type of crop. AGRO 2.2 describes the technical and legal requirements for the crop production system and accompanies the model of AGRO 2.1. It includes general rules and illustrates measures for environmentally friendly and good agricultural practice in order to produce safe and fine quality products, while achieving best environmental management.

Many issues concerning the implementation of ICM and especially that of pesticide residues are currently under investigation. A previously published paper points out that, levels of pesticide residues in fruit and vegetable samples originating from organic cultivations were considerably lower than those originating from conventional and ICM cultivations in USA (Baker, Benbrook, Groth, & Lutz Benbrook, 2002). Other relevant papers deal with a variety of topics such as: (a) the use of insecticides against the green peach
