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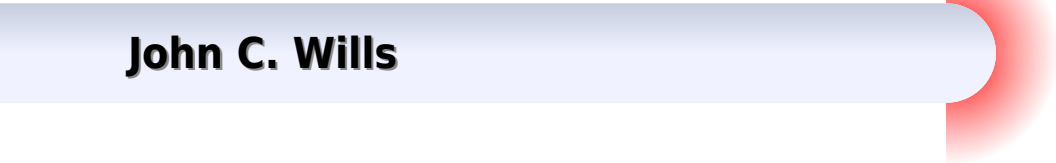

Die Verfassung vor dem Richterstuhl Jürgen Heideking, 2014-10-09 Keine ausführliche Beschreibung für Die Verfassung vor dem Richterstuhl verfügbar *Transatlantic Radicals and the Early American Republic* Michael Durey, 1997 In the transatlantic world of the late eighteenth century easterly winds blew radical thought to America Thomas Paine had already arrived on these shores in 1774 and made his mark as a radical pamphleteer during the Revolution In his wake followed more than 200 other radical exiles English Dissenters Whigs and Painites Scottish lads o parts and Irish patriots who became influential newspaper writers and editors and helped change the nature of political discourse in a young nation Michael Durey has written the first full scale analysis of these radicals evaluating the long term influence their ideas have had on American political thought *Transatlantic Radicals* uncovers the roots of their radicalism in the Old World and tells the story of how these men came to be exiled how they emigrated and how they participated in the politics of their adopted country Nearly all of these radicals looked to Paine as their spiritual leader and to Thomas Jefferson as their political champion They held egalitarian anti federalist values and promoted an extreme form of participatory democracy that found a niche in the radical wing of Jefferson s Republican Party Their divided views on slavery however reveal that democratic republicanism was unable to cope with the realities of that institution As political activists during the 1790s they proved crucial to Jefferson s 1800 presidential victory then after his views moderated and their influence waned many repatriated others drifted into anonymity and a few managed to find success in the New World Although many of these men are known to us through other histories their influence as a group has never before been so closely examined Durey persuasively demonstrates that the intellectual ferment in Britain did indeed have tremendous influence on American politics His account of that influence sheds considerable light on transatlantic political history and differences in religious political and economic freedoms Skillfully balancing a large cast of characters *Transatlantic Radicals* depicts the diversity of their experiences and shows how crucial these reluctant migrants were to shaping our republic in its formative years *The Pennsylvania Congressional Delegation, 1789-1801* Patrick Logan McLaughlin, 1983 **The Age of Federalism** Stanley Elkins, Eric McKittrick, 1995-02-23 When Thomas Jefferson took the oath of office for the presidency in 1801 America had just passed through twelve critical years years dominated by some of the towering figures of our history and by the challenge of having to do everything for the first time Washington Hamilton Madison Adams and Jefferson himself each had a share in shaping that remarkable era an era that is brilliantly captured in *The Age of Federalism* Written by esteemed historians Stanley Elkins and Eric McKittrick *The Age of Federalism* gives us a reflective deeply informed analytical survey of this extraordinary period Ranging over the widest variety of concerns political cultural economic diplomatic and military the authors provide a sweeping historical account keeping always in view not only the problems the new nation faced but also the particular individuals who tried to solve them As they move through the Federalist era they draw subtly perceptive character sketches not only of the great figures

Washington and Jefferson Talleyrand and Napoleon Bonaparte but also of lesser ones such as George Hammond Britain's frustrated minister to the United States James McHenry Adams's hapless Secretary of War the pre-Chief Justice version of John Marshall and others They weave these lively profiles into an analysis of the central controversies of the day turning such intricate issues as the public debt into fascinating depictions of opposing political strategies and contending economic philosophies Each dispute bears in some way on the broader story of the emerging nation The authors show for instance the consequences the fight over Hamilton's financial system had for the locating of the nation's permanent capital and how it widened an ideological gulf between Hamilton and the Virginians Madison and Jefferson that became unbridgeable The statesmen of the founding generation the authors believe did a surprising number of things right But Elkins and McKittrick also describe some things that went resoundingly wrong the hopelessly underfinanced effort to construct a capital city on the Potomac New York they argue would have been a far more logical choice than Washington and prosecutions under the Alien and Sedition Acts which turned into a comic nightmare No detail is left out or left uninteresting as their account continues through the Adams presidency the XYZ affair the naval Quasi War with France and the desperate Federalist maneuvers in 1800 first to prevent the reelection of Adams and then to nullify the election of Jefferson The Age of Federalism is the fruit of many years of discussion and thought in which deep scholarship is matched only by the lucid distinction of its prose With it Stanley Elkins and Eric McKittrick have produced the definitive study long awaited by historians of the early national era

Pasley, 2016-12-04 This is the first study in half a century to focus on the election of 1796 At first glance the first presidential contest looks unfamiliar parties were frowned upon there was no national vote and the candidates did not even participate the political mores of the day forbade it Yet for all that Jeffrey L. Pasley contends the election of 1796 was absolutely seminal setting the stage for all of American politics to follow Challenging much of the conventional understanding of this election Pasley argues that Federalist and Democratic Republican were deeply meaningful categories for politicians and citizens of the 1790s even if the names could be inconsistent and the institutional presence lacking He treats the 1796 election as a rough draft of the democratic presidential campaigns that came later rather than as the personal squabble depicted by other historians It set the geographic pattern of New England competing with the South at the two extremes of American politics and it established the basic ideological dynamic of a liberal rights spreading American left arrayed against a conservative society protecting right each with its own competing model of leadership Rather than the inner thoughts and personal lives of the Founders covered in so many other volumes Pasley focuses on images of Adams and Jefferson created by supporters and detractors through the press capturing the way that ordinary citizens in 1796 would have actually experienced candidates they never heard speak Newspaper editors minor officials now forgotten congressman and individual elector candidates all take a leading role in the story to show how politics of the day actually worked Pasley's
