


Brown Gold Michelle Martin, 2004-03-01. Brown Gold is a compelling history and analysis of African American children's picturebooks from the mid nineteenth century to the present. At the turn of the nineteenth century, good children's books about black life were hard to find; if indeed young black readers and their parents could even gain entry into the bookstores and libraries. But today, in the Golden Age of African American children's picturebooks, one can find a wealth of titles ranging from *Happy to be Nappy* to *Black is Brown is Tan*.
