

Plastic



Discovered in the mid-nineteenth century, plastic comes from hydrocarbons. As it presents various features and its cost is low, plastic has numerous applications.

MOLECULAR STRUCTURE

Plastic is a synthetic polymer. Polymers are macromolecules consisting of repeating smaller units: the monomers.

The monomers derive from hydrocarbons, and are primarily composed of carbon and hydrogen. Some monomers may contain nitrogen, oxygen, fluorine, etc. These monomers used to produce plastic are hydrocarbons with a simple and low-cost structure.

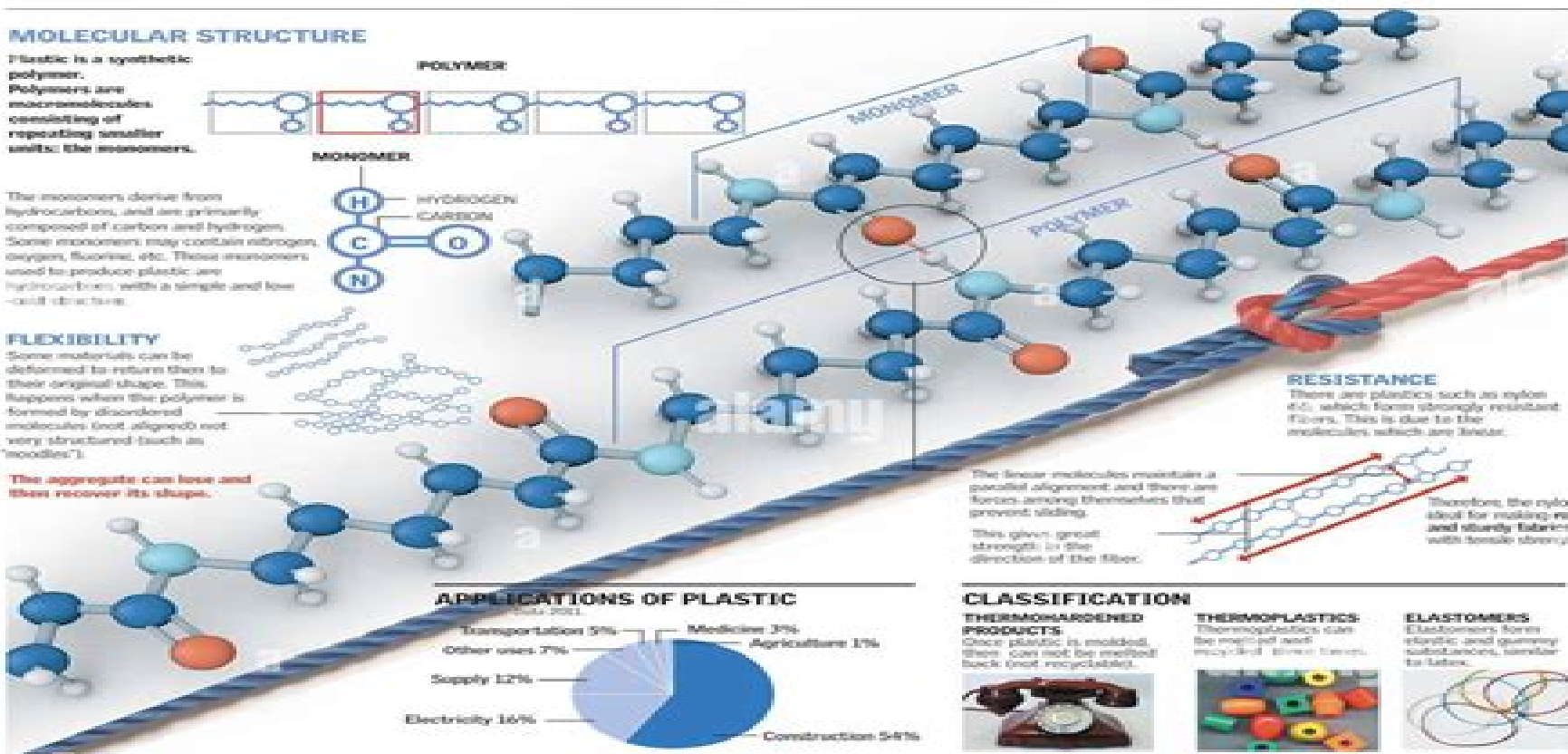
FLEXIBILITY

Some materials can be deformed to return them to their original shape. This happens when the polymer is formed by disordered molecules (not aligned not very structured (such as "noodles").

The aggregate can lose and then recover its shape.

RESISTANCE

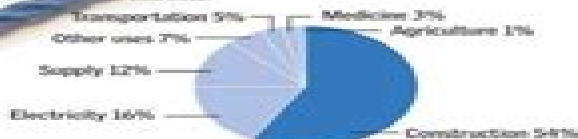
There are plastics such as nylon 6,6 which form strongly resistant fibers. This is due to the molecules which are linear.

The linear molecules maintain a parallel alignment and there are forces among themselves that prevent sliding.

This gives great strength in the direction of the fiber.

Therefore, the nylon is ideal for making ropes and sturdy fabrics with tensile strength.

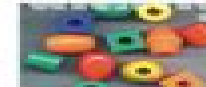
THERMOHARDENED PRODUCTS

Elastomers form elastic and gummy substances, similar to latex.



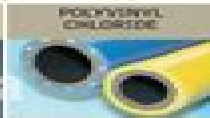
IDENTIFICATION OF THERMOPLASTICS
