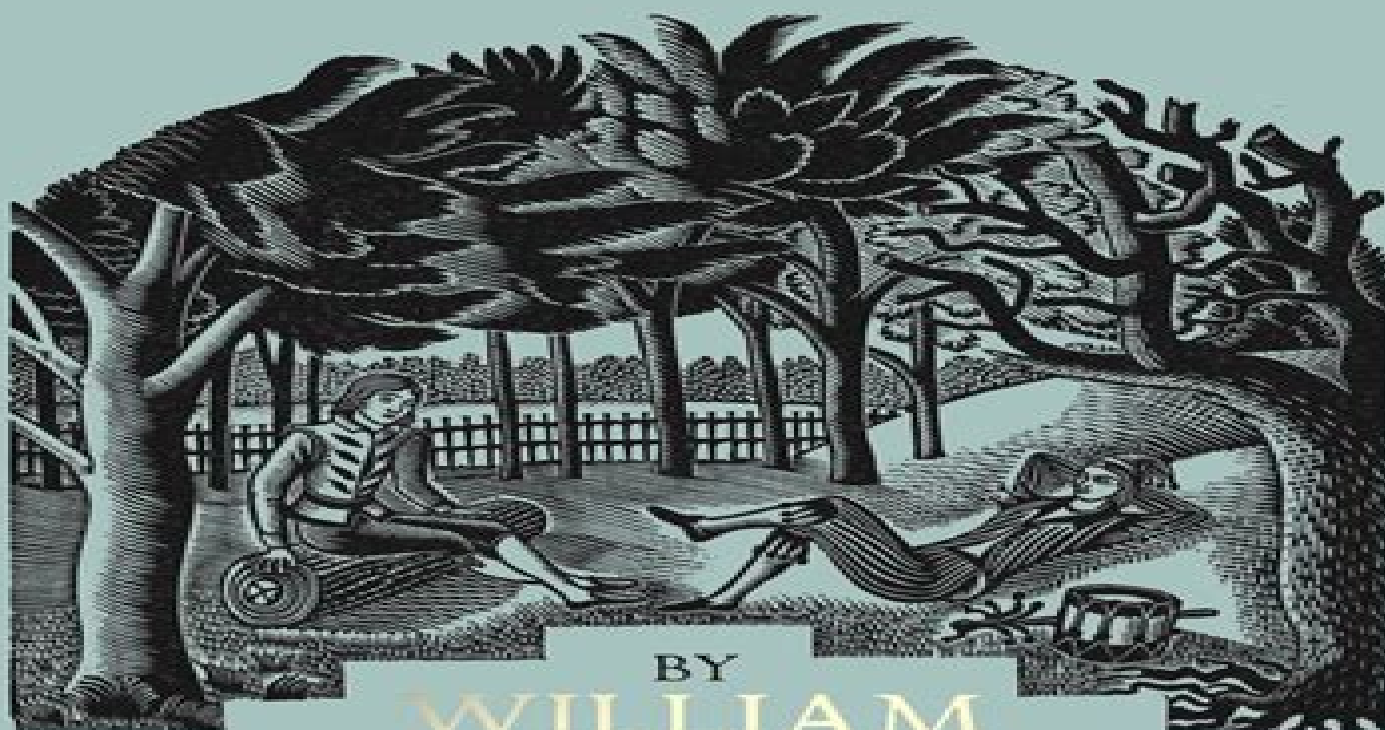

TWELFTH NIGHT William Shakespeare, Sidney Lee, 2017-12-06 This play is named after the Twelfth Night holiday of the Christmas season It was written around 1601 and first published in the First Folio in 1623 Like many of Shakespeare s comedies this one centers on mistaken identity The leading character Viola is shipwrecked on the shores of Illyria during the opening scenes She loses contact with her twin brother Sebastian whom she believes dead Posing as a man and masquerading as a young page under the name Cesario she enters the service of Duke Orsino Orsino is in love with the bereaved Lady Olivia whose brother has recently died and decides to use Cesario as an intermediary Olivia believing Viola to be a man falls in love with this handsome and eloquent messenger Viola in turn has fallen in love with the Duke who also believes Viola is a man and who regards her as his confidant

Life of William Shakespeare is a biography of William Shakespeare by the eminent critic Sidney Lee This book was one of the first major biographies of the Bard of Avon It was published in 1898 based on the article contributed to the Dictionary of National Biography William Shakespeare 1564 1616 was an English poet and playwright widely regarded as the greatest writer in the English language and the world s pre eminent dramatist He is often called England s national poet and the Bard of Avon His extant works including some collaborations consist of about 38 plays 154 sonnets two long narrative poems and a few other verses the authorship of some of which is uncertain

Maria Malvolio is angry at the deception and says he will take revenge but is talked down by Fabian The gender bending from Shakespeare s Twelfth Night is a comment on a day of revelry that was commonplace in Shakespeare s era On this twelfth night after Christmas roles were changed as women dressed as men and vice versa The celebration was based on a Roman festival called Saturnalia which was an excuse for an evening of drunken festivities and inverted social order In Twelfth Night the grumpy Malvolio can represent the adversary of these imbibed festivities The conspirators that aim to humiliate Malvolio Sir Toby Belch and Sir Andrew Aguecheek representing the comic revelers The play was written to be performed at Christmastide and was performed right after its completion in 1602 Shakespeare borrowed some elements of the story from Barnabe Rich s short story entitled Of Apollonius and Silla which was in turn based on Matteo Bandello s story
