The presentation intentionally avoids a finger-wagging 'thou shalt not' approach in favor of a 'how to' discussion of good laboratory and industrial practice. It is focused on hazards and remedies that might be encountered in the use of instrumentation. Among the new topics introduced in this edition are photoacoustic spectroscopy, cryogenic NMR probes and actively shielded magnets, the nature of mixtures in the context of separations, troubleshooting and leaks in high vacuum systems such as mass spectrometers, instrumentation laboratory safety, standard reference materials and standard reference data.
