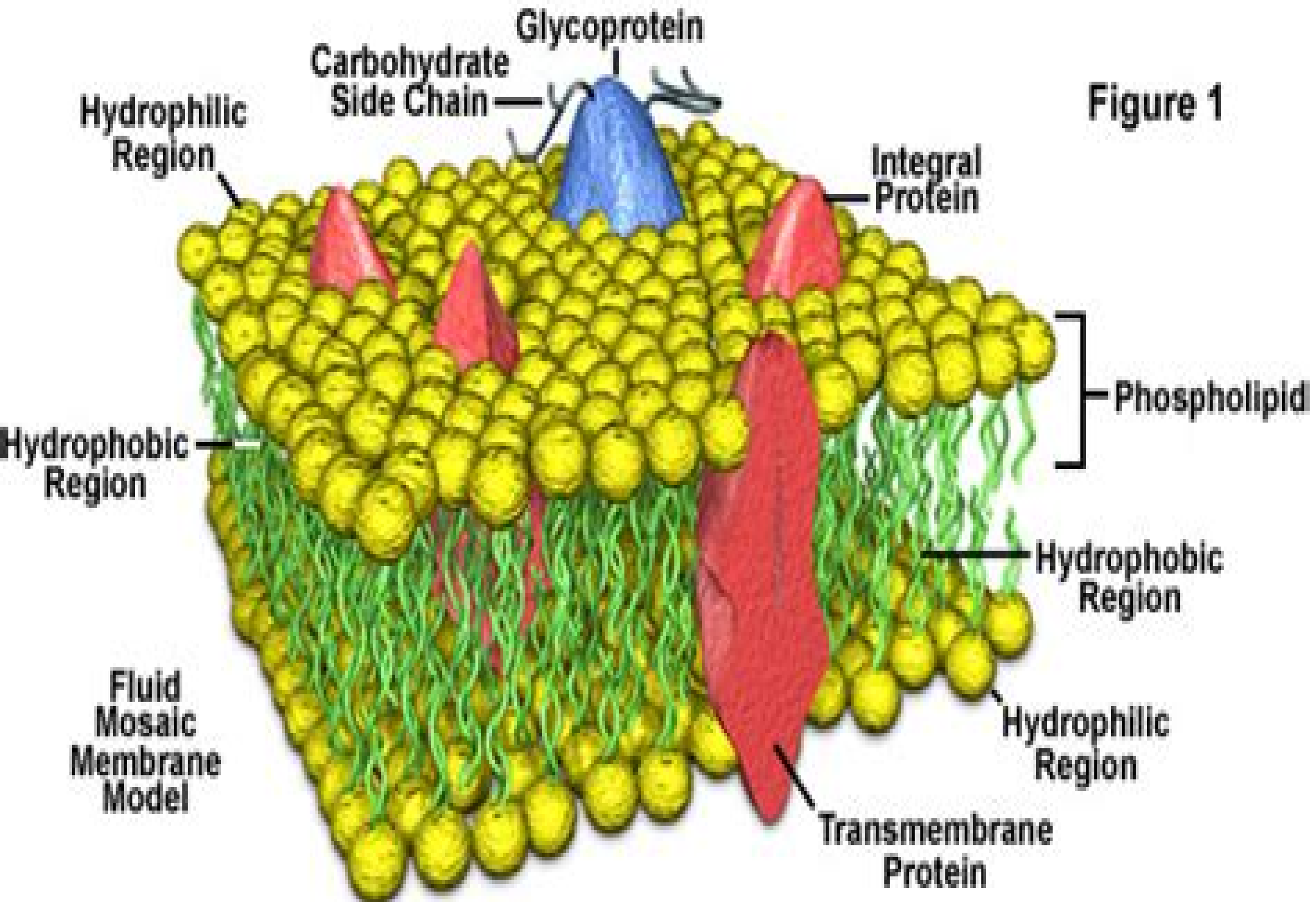

For this reason it has a wide range of important functions related to the regulation of the composition of the cell interior and to communication with the cell exterior. Until the early 1970s it was only possible to study the plasma membrane in situ, its structure e.g. by electron microscopy and its function e.g. by uptake of radioactively labeled compounds into the intact cell or tissue.
