- In situ Hybridization (ISH): a highly sensitive and specific method detects, as target nucleic acid, the viral <u>DNA or RNA</u> in tissue sections or cytological preparations.

 - Examples: detecting HCMV DNA in urine and puffy-coat specimens from neonates and bone marrow transplant recipients.
 - Detection of different types of HPV in cancer of the cervix.
