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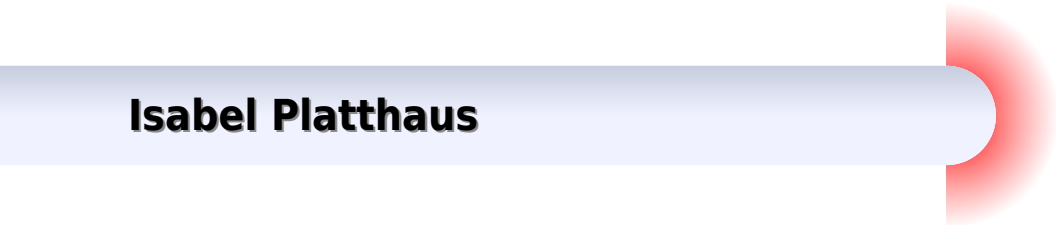

Shaffer, 2000-02-24 Comparative Criticism addresses itself to the questions of literary theory and criticism to comparative studies in terms of theme genre movement and influence and to interdisciplinary perspectives This new volume takes Myth and mythologies as its central theme Articles include the Shadow of Ulysses beyond 2001 Genesis a tale of a heel and a hip Myths of High and Low the Lyrical Ballads 1798 1998 and Myths of the Indies Jane Austen and the British Empire The winning entries in the 1997 8 BCLA BCLT translation competition are published as well as a special bibliography on the works of H G Adler **The Shadow of Ulysses** Piero Boitani, 1994 Simultaneously ancient and modern the figure of Ulysses is an ideal observation point from which to measure the similarities and differences between the otherness alterity of the past and the modernity of the present Boitani sees Ulysses as a figure which every culture is free to interpret according to his values rooted on the one hand in the mythical qualities of Odysseus as a character and on the other in the ideals problems and philosophical ethical and political horizons of the individual civilization The Shadow of Ulysses follows the evolution of the sign through the ages returning continuously as it does so to problems of intertextuality interpretation and reading The sign appears as a shadow both because by means of it poetry describes humanity's journey to the other world of death and because in a figural connotation Ulysses foreshadows Columbus's and Vespucci's historical voyages to the New World *The Odyssey of Political Theory* Patrick J. literatures and literary response to Pieter Brueghel's The Fall of Icarus Honing in on modern figures and concerns Boitani also offers a fascinating discussion of author pilot Antoine de Saint Exupéry and concludes with a meditation on the flight of the hijacked airliners on 9/11 Throughout Winged Word brings a remarkable range of men of action politicians theologians writers and artists into dialogue with each other Shakespeare with T.S. Eliot Horace with Ovid Leonardo with Milton Leopardi with Mallarmé Saint Exupéry with Faulkner and Rilke and the Ulysses of Homer with the Ulysses of Dante Ultimately by showing how writers and fliers have looked to the ancients for inspiration Boitani testifies to the modern relevance of poetry and the classics
