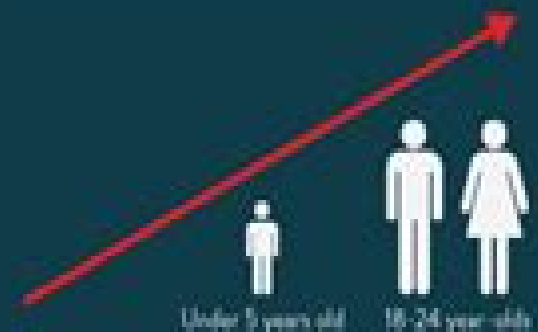
Number of poor children receiving cash aid: one in five.



Children under age 18 in poverty: 16.4 million, or **22 percent** of all children, including **39 percent** of African-American children, **35 percent** of Latino children, and **12 percent** of white children.



Over the last 50 years, the steepest increase in poverty rates was among children under 5, and those in early adulthood aged 18-24.
