sense that the per capita cost of reaching a specific level of welfare does not fall as household size increases Relaxing that assumption could affect comparisons showing higher poverty rates among the elderly because their households tend to be smaller than the households containing children Even the nature of the transition has implications for economies of scale The relative cost of housing and other goods and services with at least some public good characteristics has risen rapidly These relative price shifts hit small households particularly hard because a greater share of their expenditures goes to public and quasi public goods But transition economies have also experienced big increases in the relative prices of goods and services consumed largely by children such as kindergarten and other education services.
