services were better at working with their allies than others while also pointing to rare successes such as Rommel's effective coordination with Italian forces in North Africa. In the end while some individual Axis units fought with distinction if not on a par with the vaunted Wehrmacht and helped Germany achieve some of its military aims the coalition's overall military performance was riddled with disappointments.
